1. Submit your application and \$50 vendor fee by April 17, 2020. **Make your check payable to Westcott Community Center and mail your application and check to Westcott Community Center 826 Euclid Avenue, Syracuse, NY 13210, attention Jake Losowski.**  
*Note: Multiple artists displaying at the same booth, tent or table must each pay the \$50 vendor fee (unless all products for sale are produced by both artists and you share the proceeds).*
2. Email photographs (max 3) of your work to [JakeL@westcottcc.org](mailto:JakeL@westcottcc.org). (At least 300 dpi photos are required for our Website and Press Releases.) Your photos, name and website address will be showcased on Westcott Community Center's website in the Art Trail page for the year.
3. All items for sale must be handmade by the artist.
4. Your booth must be open during all advertised sale hours.

---

The trail map highlights the location of each artist and briefly describes the art being sold. Throughout the neighborhood yard signs, posters, and flags will also help customers locate each site. Trail maps will be available in late May on the Center's Art Trail page at [westcottcc.org](http://westcottcc.org) and for pick-up at the Center and Petit Library.

The planning committee will contact you in May to confirm your booth location.

**Get your application in by the deadline of April 17<sup>th</sup>. You may still participate if you miss the deadline, but a \$15 late fee is required and unfortunately your information will not be listed on the map.**
